The requirements are the same as the French, however the differences for Djibouti are:-

- ➤ A valid passport (must be valid for six months)
- ➤ 2 colour Photographs
- ➤ 2 Application forms
- > Itinerary
- Proof of accommodation
- Original and one photocopy of the Air ticket
- ➤ Insurance and breakdown (min of Euros 30 000)
- ➤ Proof of Foreign exchange receipt (min of R400.00 per day per person) OR recent 3mnth Credit card statements

- > South African Business Letter
- ➤ Invitation letter from the company in Djibouti

Minors

- Notarized parental consent is required for persons under 18 years of age if they are not traveling with a parent or legal guardian, OR if they are traveling with on parent only
- > Need Childs full unabridged Birth Certificate

Processing Time

➤ 7 to 21 Working Days – (depending on the Passport the passenger is holding and if the application needs to be referred AND when there is a available appointment.at the French Consulate)
