### **GAUTENG**

- The French Consulate issues on behalf of Djibouti  
The requirements are the same as the French, however, the differences for Djibouti are:-
- A valid passport (must be valid for six months)
- 2 colour Photographs
- 2 Application forms
- Itinerary
- Proof of accommodation
- Original and one photocopy of the Air ticket
- Insurance and breakdown (min of Euros 30 000)
- Proof of Foreign exchange (min of R400.00 per day per person)

### **Special requirements for Holiday**

- South African Employment Letter

### **Special requirements for Business**

- South African Business Letter
- Invitation letter from the company in Djibouti

### **Minors**

- Notarized parental consent is required for persons under 18 years of age if they are not traveling with a parent or legal guardian, OR if they are traveling with on parent only
- Need Child full unabridged Birth Certificate

### **Processing Time**

- 7 – 21 Working Days depending if the application needs to be referred and the passport the passenger is holding.
