## VISA REQUIREMENTS

### **NEW regulations are in place at Tripoli International Airport:**

All foreign nationals entering Libya through the airport must have an Arabic translation of their personal data (photo page of the passport) and the translation must be endorsed or affixed on the passport by a legal translator and must be validated by their stamp. If the translator does not validate the translation, the passenger must contact his embassy/consulate to validate it.

Arabic translation letters issued by translation service providers, embassies or consulates are still not acceptable. All passengers must also carry US\$1000 in cash, or equivalent in other currencies.

## **GAUTENG/CAPE TOWN/DURBAN**

- All passport holders will require a translation into Arabic, of their passports, in order to enter Libya. Visas International can do this on behalf of passenger.
- Completed application form
- Valid passport (Valid for 6 months from date of return)
- 2 color photos
- Flight itinerary
- Yellow fever

### **Special requirements for Business**

- South African Business Letter
- Invitation/acceptance letter from company in Libya. This must be sent first directly to the embassy.

### **Special Requirements for Tourist**

- Employment letter
- Proof of accommodation

### **Processing time**

- 5 days
