Schengen State requirements- As from the beginning of June 2013

Passengers over the age of 12 years when submitting for the 1st time will be required to have their fingerprints taken. (These fingerprints will remain on the system for 5 years)

Visas International can do the following:

- Collection of Visa Applications and dropping off as Normal
- Checking and preparing the documentation (making sure all the correct requirements are there)
- Making and paying for appointments (Depending on available appointment slots)
- Meeting and assisting the passenger at the Embassy as well as handing over the Correct documentation in order for the passenger to submit
- Collection of the passport once the Embassy has finalised the application

Malta has joined the Schengen agreement. If you have a valid Schengen visa, it can be used to enter Malta. Applicants need to apply in person. Visas must be done directly through the Italian embassy in Pretoria
