VISA REQUIREMENTS

The Mauritius High Commission has announced that any foreign nationals, including South Africans, who have visited one or more of the countries affected by Ebola will temporarily not be allowed entry into their country

The Ebola affected countries are:

- Nigeria
- Sierra Leone
- Guinea
- Liberia
- Senegal
- Democratic Republic of Congo

GAUTENG

- ➤ Valid passport (must be valid for six month) plus photocopies
- Foreign passport holders must provide satisfactory proof of immigration status in South Africa
- ➤ One original completed application form with the applicants' signature
- ➤ One passport size photograph
- Detailed itinerary
- ➤ Copy of the Air Ticket

Special requirements for Tourists

- > South African employment letter
- > Confirmation of hotel reservation direct from the hotel in Mauritius
- ➤ A bank letter confirming that the passenger has sufficient funds (R300.00) per day

Special requirements for Business

- South African business letter confirming that the company will be responsible for all the applicants' expenses
- ➤ Letter of invitation from the company in Mauritius stating the nature & purpose of the business
- Confirmation of hotel reservation direct from the hotel in Mauritius.

Minors

➤ Certified parental consent is required for persons under 18 years of age if they are not travelling with a parent or legal guardian, OR if they are travelling with one parent only

Processing Time

➤ 3 weeks depending on nationality of the passport holder

NB: South African passport holders at present do not require visas, however the passport must be valid for six months from date of departure from Mauritius

and the passenger must be in possession of a valid return ticket
