Subject to Regularization (STR) Visa Checklist

Apply for a STR Visa if you are travelling to Nigeria (for more than 3 months) for:

- Any type of work
- Family member of someone settled in Nigeria, who is intending to live in Nigeria

APPLICANTS FOR VISA/S ARE TO SUBMIT THEIR APPLICATIONS IN PERSON AS YOU'RE NOW REQUIRED TO CAPTURE YOUR BIOMETRICS AS PART OF THE VISA REQUIREMENTS

Documentation Required:

- 1. Passport/Travel Document with minimum of 6 months validity. Must have a minimum of 2 empty visa pages.
- 2. 4 recent passport sized photographs
- 3. Letter of Request for STR visa on behalf of the expatriate from the company in Nigeria (Four copies).
- 4. Certificate of incorporation from company in Nigeria (Four copies).
- 5. Completed IMM/22 forms with photographs (Typed) (Four copies).
- 6. Complete entry visa application form online at https://visa.immigration.gov.ng/. Once completed this must be printed out, signed and dated by applicant (Four Copies).
- 7. Print payment and acknowledgement slips once online payment is complete from portal.immigration.gov.ng/visa/OnlineQueryStatus
- 8. Four copies of the valid Expatriate Quota clearly showing the position and four certified copies of the Expatriate from quota from the inviting company in Nigeria.
- 9. Applicant's Resume and copies of all qualification declared. These should match the intented job position offered (Four copies each).
- 10. Offer of Employment, Letter of Acceptance of offer and Contract of the employment (Four copies each).
- 11. Inviting Companies must attach company tax returns.
- 12. Photocopies of data page of Applicant's passport, and ID if South Africans. (Four copies)
- 13. Flight booking (not a confirmation) (Four copies) (Optional).

Documentation Instructions:

- EXPATRIATE QUOTA MUST BE VALID FOR AT LEAST SIX MONTHS PRIOR TO APPLICATION.
- IMMIGRATION FORM IMM 22 MUST NOT BE MORE THAN 3 PAGES WHEN PRINTED.
- POSITIONS TO BE HELD MUST BE CONSISTENT TO WHAT IS APPROVED ON THE EXPATRIATE QUOTA.
- DOCUMENTS NOT IN ENGLISH MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH A CERTIFIED TRANSLATED COPY.
- ALL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS MUST BE IN COLOUR, EXCLUDING APPLICATION FORM/ PAYMENT RECIEPTS, FLIGHT TICKETS AND HOTEL RESERVATION.
- ALL LETTERS MUST BE ADDRESSED TO: THE NIGERIA HIGH COMMISSION, 971 FRANCIS BAARD STREET, ARCADIA, PRETORIA.
- ALL DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED MUST BE IN QUADRUPLE.
- ALL LETTERS SHOULD BE SIGNED, DATED WITH VALID TELEPHONE NUMBERS.
- NON-SOUTH AFRICAN PASSPORT HOLDER MUST PROVIDE LEGAL RESIDENCE (Resident Visa/Permit).
- ECOWAS CITIZENS MUST SHOW PROOF OF LEGAL ENTRY INTO SA.
- APPLICANT MAY BE INVITED FOR INTERVIEW BEFORE VISA/ ENTRY PERMITS ARE ISSUED.
- A VALID PASSPORT DATA PAGE OF INVITEE MUST BE SUBMITTED.

- SOUTH AFRICAN PASSPORT HOLDERS MUST PROVIDE COPY OF ID, ORIGINAL MUST BE SHOWN WHEN SUBMITTING APPLICATION.
- ANY VISITORS INVITED BY A CHURCH IN NIGERIA MUST SUBMIT AN AUTHORIZATION LETTER FROM THE NIGERIAN FEDERAL MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (THE CHURCH MUST REQUEST FOR THIS LETTER ON BEHALF OF APPLICANT).
- PLEASE COME WITH ORIGINAL MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE FOR VERIFICATION PURPOSE ONLY.
- PLEASE MAKE AND KEEP COPIES OF ALL DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED BECAUSE NO THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT DOCUMENTS WOULD BE RETURNED.
- ALL REQUIRMENT AND PROCEDURE ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE.
- DO NOT CONFIRM FLIGHT OR HOTEL RESERVATIONS BEFORE DECISION OF VISA ISSUANCE.
