VISA REQUIREMENTS

Procedure for applying for visas. Please note clients must appear in person for an interview.

STAGE 1:

Two application forms must be filled in, signed and fingerprinted by the applicant. Gather the requirements mentioned below. Scan the documents and submit them to the Consular Sections's email address (embaperu6@telkomsa.net). This will create a portfolio that will be evaluated for approval purposes. Once your submission has been approved shall you received a notification email there of.

STAGE 2:

The following step after your submission has been approved would be the payment of the Business Visa fee which will be given within the approval notification email.

Special requirements for Business

- Valid passport (must be valid for six months) plus copy.
- 2 x application forms.
- 2 x colour photos
- SA letter
- Invitation letter from the company in Peru stating the nature of business in Peru.
- Letter from the traveller stating personal details, reasons for travelling and the means of accounting for it.

Processing Time

- Embassy will email client when visa is ready.
