- Valid passport (must be valid for six months) No temporary South African passport is accepted.
- ➤ Fully completed application form (to be completed in triplicate).
- > Three passport size colour photographs.
- If the passenger is a foreign passport holder, a copy of his/her residence status or a copy of his/her South African ID is required.
- ➤ 3 Months recent bank statements.
- Original Yellow fever

Special requirements for Tourists

- South African employment letter.

Special requirements for Business

- Letter of invitation from Sudanese company.
- Letter from the South African Company.

Minors

Notarised parental consent is required for persons under 18 years of age if they are not travelling with a parent or legal guardian, OR if they are travelling with one parent only.
