

## SUDAN

### VISA REQUIREMENTS

### GAUTENG

- Valid passport (must be valid for six months) – No temporary South African passport is accepted.
- Fully completed application form (to be completed in triplicate).
- Three passport size colour photographs.
- If the passenger is a foreign passport holder, a copy of his/her residence status or a copy of his/her South African ID is required.
- 3 Months recent bank statements.
- Original Yellow fever

#### **Special requirements for Tourists**

- South African employment letter.
- The inviting party in Sudan must register an applicant’s visit with the Foreign Ministry. The Ministry will then send an official invitation directly to the Sudanese Consulate

#### **Special requirements for Business**

- Letter of invitation from Sudanese company.
- Letter from the South African Company.

- The inviting party in Sudan must register an applicant's visit with the Foreign Ministry. The Ministry will then send an official invitation directly to the Sudanese Consulate.

### **Minors**

- Notarised parental consent is required for persons under 18 years of age if they are not travelling with a parent or legal guardian, OR if they are travelling with one parent only.

### **Processing Time**

- 21 working days.

### **South Sudan**

Submission days: Monday, Wednesday and Friday

NOTE: The visa will only be granted once authorisation has come through from Sudan
