VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR SPOUSES/CHILDREN OF SWISS OR EU/EFTA-NATIONALS

The visa application must be submitted to the competent office. Please find the relevant information on the link "Where to apply": https://www.eda.admin.ch/countries/south-africa/en/home/visa/entry-residency/visa/visaantrag.html

Each application must be complete with all the required documents. Note that no copies will be made by the Embassy on your behalf and incomplete applications won't be accepted. 1 Schengen visa application form duly filled in, dated and signed, sign where ever it says signature https://www.sem.admin.ch/sem/en/home/themen/einreise/visumantragsformular.html Minors: (under the age of 18) Both parents must sign the visa application form. We need the following: a) the minor's unabridged birth certificate (containing fathers and mother name) b) certified copies of ID/passport of both parents certified copies of Schengen Visa of both parents (if in possession of and if travelling with the child) d) if the minor travels alone: certified parental consent by both parents e) if the minor travels with only one parent: the other parent must produce the certified consent. If only one parent has quardianship of the minor, the relevant court documents / or death certificate 2 passport-size colour photographs, not older than 6 months, (undamaged, of good quality and of recent date). Do not staple or damage the photo, background has to be light and plain. For more details, please refer to: http://www.icao.int/Security/mrtd/Downloads/Technical%20Reports/Annex A-Photograph Guidelines.pdf Valid national passport (issued within the last 10 years), with at least 3 months validity after the scheduled return from the Schengen States and with at least 2 blank pages. Photocopy of the passport including the signature page and previous Schengen visas Round trip reservation and detailed itinerary including dates and flight numbers specifying the dates of entry and exit from the territory of the Member States. If applicable: proof of Inter-Schengen travel (car rental/flights/train and/or bus tickets). Important: Do not buy the actual flight ticket before the visa has been issued. Photocopy of the marriage certificate. Photocopy of the unabridged birth certificate (if applicant is a minor or below 21 years of age) Photocopy of the passport of the Swiss or EU/EFTA-Spouse. Please come in person if it's your first Schengen visa or the previous one expired more than 2 years ago.

Please note that you can apply for a visa at the earliest 90 days prior your intended day of entry

into one of the Schengen Member States.
