## **VISA REQUIREMENTS**

#### **GAUTENG**

- ➤ Valid passport (must be valid for six months)
- ➤ Original, fully completed application form with the applicants' signature in capital letters.
- > Two recent passport size photographs
- > Detailed itinerary
- Copy of airline ticket
- > Yellow Fever certificate
- ➤ Bank letter verifying opening date of account, number and type of account and current balance available. Please note that the bank letter and statements must have bank stamp on it.

# **Special requirements for Tourists**

- ➤ South African employment letter stating length of employment, position, salary
- > Three months recent bank statements

### **Special requirements for Business**

> South African business letter

Letter of invitation from the company in Venezuela (no emails)

### Minors

➤ Certified parental consent is required for persons under 18 years of age if they are not travelling with a parent or legal guardian, OR if they are travelling with one parent only

## **Processing Time**

➤ 2 working days

**NB**: South African passport holders at present no longer require visas for tourism purposes. A DEX 2 card must be applied for in the final destination (the flight taking passenger into Venezuela). This DEX 2 card allows the passenger 90 days in Venezuela, however, it is advisable to call the Consulate when going on business
