

Mandatory Documents for UAE Visa Applications:

1. Clear, Colour Copy of Passport

- All four corners must be visible.
- Passport must have a minimum validity of six months.

2. Colour copy of the outer cover of Passport

- Place the passport flat and scan so that both sides are showing at the same time

3. Clear, Colour ID-Style Photograph

- Full face must be clearly visible.
- Selfies are not accepted.

4. Confirmed Hotel Booking – *MUST BE IN PDF FORMAT*

- Full names and surnames of all applicants must be listed (*as per passport*)
- Hotel stay dates must match the flight itinerary.
- Confirmation number and payment details must be included.

5. Staying with Family or Friends (*Applicable for 30-day and 60-day visas*)

- A valid tenancy contract and a copy (front and back) of the host's UAE Emirates ID are required.

6. Confirmed Airline Ticket

- Must include entry and exit details, ticket number, and be issued by the airline.
- Travel dates must align with hotel booking dates.

7. Applicants Under 18 Years Old

- Must apply and travel with at least one parent.
- An unabridged birth certificate is required.

Transit Visas (48 and 96 Hours):

Please note the recent update from CVS, effective immediately:

- All applicants, regardless of nationality, must provide a valid visa copy for the country they are traveling to or arriving from.

Important:

Effective immediately, all visa applicants are required to submit a hotel confirmation that includes the booking reference number and payment details. The hotel booking must match the flight itinerary, including both arrival and departure dates.

Kindly take note of the following important points:

- Refunds are not applicable once the visa application is in process.
- Refunds will not be issued in the event of a visa rejection.
- Immigration authorities may request additional supporting documents, such as previous/old passports.
- The visa processing time is approximately 3–5 working days; however, this is subject to change.
- Final approval remains at the sole discretion of the immigration authorities.
- Please be advised that non-South African passport holders have an estimated 50/50 chance of visa approval, as determined by UAE Immigration.
- If you currently hold an active visa, your application through us may be rejected.
